In the spring, the students will have the opportunity to take the S.T.A.M.P. (standards based measure of proficiency) test. There are three sections to the computer test: reading comprehension, oral proficiency and writing proficiency. Students who score a 3 or better on any one (or more) section of the test will be eligible to take Spanish II at the high school. This year's fee will be around \$18.
